

## Sura 19, verse 98

The last verse in Sura 19 is verse 98.

Verse 19:98 is the 2346<sup>th</sup> verse from the beginning of the Quran and 2346 is the 1998<sup>th</sup> composite. It is also the 572<sup>nd</sup> revealed verse in the initialed Suras.

The 572<sup>nd</sup> twin Gaussian prime pair is (89563, 89567). Note a Gaussian prime is a prime number which is NOT factorable in the complex domain. For example prime number 17 is not a Gaussian prime because it is the product of two complex numbers  $(4 - i)$  and  $(4 + i)$ . Recall,  $i = \sqrt{-1}$ . Twin Gaussian primes are those Gaussian primes that differ by 4, such as (19, 23).

Gaussian prime 89567 is the 1143<sup>rd</sup> sequential twin Gaussian prime and  $1143 = 9 \times 127$ . Furthermore, the 1143<sup>rd</sup> composite is 1362 which is the number of verses from 1:1 to 9:127.

Recall that the order of revelation of the verses are independent of the number verses in Sura 9.

Furthermore, we note that the 572<sup>nd</sup> composite is 698. The function of the number 698 is to generate the revelation order of sura 19 which happens to be 6<sup>th</sup> initialed sura revealed. Let me point out that the 572 is the number of verses revealed in the initialed suras which corresponds to the 6<sup>th</sup> revealed sura verse 98.
