

Ultimate Mathematics Generates the Number of Salat's or Contact Prayers A Gift from God

The awesomeness of Quran is highlighted in 59:21. This verse is shown below with its sequential position as **5145**.

5145 2454 5704 2961 1702 21	Had We revealed this Quran to a mountain, you would have seen it humbling itself reverently out of fear for God₂₅₁₄. And these are examples that We cite for people that they may think.

The number 59 is a prime number and it is the 17th prime number.

The factors of **5145** are **3 7 7 5 7**. Furthermore the composite number **5145** is the index of composite **5924** and note that sura **59** has **24** verses. The index of composite **5145** is **4459** and note again that sura **44** has **59** verses. Therefore, the position of the above verse tells us that two suras in the Quran namely 44 and 59 have to have 59 and 24 respectively. Since, 5145th verse is 59:21, then let us look at 5921. We note that; the factors of 5921 are 31 191. The indices of the primes 31 and 191 are 11 and 43. The number $11 \times 43 = 473$ and it confirms that sura 9 has 127 verses. Moreover, the 5921st (31×191) verse from the beginning of the Quran happens to be the 473rd verse revealed. The number can be written as $473 = 11 \times 43$.

Now let us go back to the factors of 5145. They are;

3 7 7 5 7

The indices of these prime numbers are

2 4 4 3 4

A legitimate question would be, “why this specific order in writing the factors”? The answer is that the number 37757 is 17×2221 . 17 being the number of units in daily contact prayers and 2221 is a prime and its index is the prime 331 with an index of 67 which is another prime, and happens to be the 19th prime. Furthermore, there are exactly 67 twin prime pairs before the lonely prime 2221. Note that 67 is the exactly the nimber of times the word “Salat” has been mentioned in the Quran. Note that 2221 is the 198th lonely prime and the index of composite 198 is $152 = 19 \times 8$. Again note that 19 is the 8th prime number.

I like to emphasize that these are only reminders and the Salat cannot be taught or forced upon people, but it is inspired to people by God as it is stated by God in 21:73.
